Hattiesburg High School is having a great year! We completely embraced your strategies and have totally changed the culture of our school. We cannot be more pleased with the outcome. In September, we received our school's ratings, and the results were impressive. This is the highest performance rating a school can receive in the State of Mississippi.
